



Visitor Parking Information Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH)

What type of parking is available for visitors to the capitol complex?

Plant Management (PMD) offers contract parking, daily parking permits and metered parking in the capitol complex.

How much does it cost to park?

The Fiscal Year 2007 parking rates are:

\$29.75/month - Parking Lot

\$51.67/month - Parking Ramp

\$34.13/month - Parking Ramp Top Deck Rate (COB Orange level)

\$4.00/day - Daily Parking Permit

\$1.00/hr - Metered Parking in PMD Lot

\$1.50/hr - Metered Parking on City Street

Rates are subject to change; usually in July of each year.

I need parking on a regular basis; may I apply for contract parking through the mini-lottery?

Employees, vendors and customers of the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) may apply for contract parking through the mini-lottery. See Contract Parking and Metropass General Information sheet for more details.

What facilities have daily parking permits available and how do they work?

Daily Parking Permits may be purchased in PMD's offices located in room G10 of the Administration Building, 50 Sherburne Ave. The closest facilities that have daily parking permits available are COB ramp orange level, Lot K and Lot Q. Daily parking permits may be purchased up to 6 months in advance, but are non refundable.

What parking facilities have metered parking available? What are the time limits?

Parking meters are available in the 14th Street lot, Lot K, COB ramp orange level and Lot Q. There is also some metered parking available on local city streets. Time limits are:

14th Street Lot - 2 hour limit (the time limit in this facility will likely increase)

Lot K - 4 hour limit

COB ramp orange level - 4 hour limit

LOT Q - 3, 4, or 10 hour limit depending on meter

Will there be a new parking facility by the Stassen Building?

With the support of OAH and the Departments of Revenue, Agriculture and Health, Admin has requested funds to acquire the property at 639 Jackson St. This request has received the Governor's recommendation and is currently being considered by the legislature.

Two separate areas for visitor parking are proposed. The existing 14th Street metered lot would be reconfigured for 60 stalls: 8 for disabled parking and 52 for contract holders. The new lot at 639 Jackson will have 77 metered parking stalls. The parking meters would be available for up to 10 hours (all day).

The rates for these lots will be set at a level to fully recover the cost of the associated debt service. The monthly contract rate will likely be around \$175/month and the meters will be approximately \$2.25/hour. This compares to other lot rates of \$29.75 and other Admin meter rates of \$1/hour and City of St. Paul rates of \$1.50/hour.
